XBOX LIVE GOLFER OF THE WEEK – New Mexico State's Danny Bowen has been named the Xbox Live Western Athletic Conference Golfer of the Week.

Bowen, a senior from Albuquerque, N.M., won his first collegiate tournament as he outlasted teammate Ben Kreger in a one-hole playoff to capture the individual medal at the Cowboy Classic in Scottsdale, Ariz. Behind Bowen and Kreger's play, the Aggies, as a team, won their second tournament of the year and third ever under head coach Scott Lieberwirth. Bowen, who fired three consecutive rounds under 70 (69-68-68), won the event with a three-round score of 5-under-par 205. Bowen currently leads the Aggies with four top-10 finishes and a scoring average of 71.96. The Aggies two wins this season mark the first time since the 1995-96 season that NMSU has won two tournaments in the same year. That season, the Aggies won the NMSU/Coca-Cola Classic and the Red Raider Intercollegiate.

Others nominated: Graham DeLaet, Boise State and Danny Buell, San Jose State.

WAC CHAMPIONSHIP – The 2006 Wells Fargo WAC Championship travels to Boise, Idaho and Crane Creek Country Club. This year's Championship will be held May 1-3, 2006. A tight, challenging par 71, 6,255 yard (from the blue tees), this 18-hole golf facility is the centerpiece of Crane Creek Country Club, designed by the noted golf course architectural firm, Bob Baldock & Sons. Nestled in two valleys along the Boise foothills this golf experience is absolutely unbeatable. The course at Crane Creek is often playable year round, and is expertly groomed and manicured to ensure optimum playing conditions.
